



Conductor: **Jenny Going**

Jenny is delighted to be conducting her first concert as Principal Conductor of the Ballarat Symphony Orchestra.

In addition, Jenny has been Musical Director of the Essendon Symphony since 2008. She has conducted some of Melbourne's leading ensembles including the Zelman Symphony, Melbourne University Biomedical Students Orchestra and Hopkins Sinfonia. Jenny is committed to supporting young musicians as conductor at Melbourne Youth Music's summer school and founded the West Melbourne Schools Orchestra.

Jenny completed her Masters of Music Performance degree specialising in orchestral conducting at The University of Melbourne under Benjamin Northey and was honoured to be the inaugural recipient of the Rosemary and John Hopkins Award in 2015, her final year. Jenny also works with ABODA Victoria as a conductor mentor at various professional development events.

During her music career Jenny has worked as a professional trombonist with the Royal New Zealand Navy Band, performed on stage with Randy Breaker, Arturo Sandoval, Robin Eubanks and Rob McConnell during her time studying in America, and toured extensively throughout the west coast of the USA and recorded with Ska Band 'Ruder Than You'.

Yvonne began learning the violin at the age of four. She later studied under Miwako Abe and Gerard van der Weide whilst on full scholarship at the Victorian College of the Arts Secondary School. Yvonne went on to complete her Bachelor of Music and Graduate Diploma in Education at Monash and Melbourne Universities.

In 2003, Yvonne moved to Ballarat to take on the position as Head of Strings and classroom music teacher at Ballarat Clarendon College. Since 2013, Yvonne has been working as a violin specialist and CRT at several local schools including The Ballarat Steiner School, Damascus and Ballarat Christian College and she also teaches at her home studio.

Yvonne has had extensive chamber and orchestral experience, performing and touring overseas with the Monash University and Geminiani Chamber Orchestras. Yvonne is the founder of 'The Eureka Strings' and performs with the 'Klemantyne' Ensemble along with local theatre companies. This year marks 20 years Yvonne has been playing in the BSO and she has been Orchestra Leader since 2016.
